- Acts as a liaison with the Business Performance Office (BPO) to ensure General Terms & Conditions (GT&C) are completed and loaded within the Treasury G-Invoicing and DAI systems.
- Maintains awareness of trading partner readiness across the federal agencies to ensure compliance with G-Invoicing requirements
- Reconcile G-Invoicing CARS and E2E Billing Reports.
